

Public Notice

The Lawrence County Engineer through its contractors will be conducting Herbicidal Spraying along County Maintained Road beginning May 15th and periodically throughout the summer in order to control invasive weeds, brush and grasses that cause obstructions to the traveling public. These applications will include guardrail and signs, roadside Johnson Grass and Brush. **All mowed yards and maintained roadsides will not be sprayed.**

Anyone not wanting roadside brush / Johnson Grass sprayed along their property adjacent to the County Roadway may fill out a form available from the Engineer's office agreeing to maintain the roadside along their property as opposed to County spraying. You may not opt-out of Roadside mowing unless you completely mow the entire right of way adjacent to your property.
